### Scouting's Silver Beaver award presented to former Bogalusan

ALBANY, Ga.—A former Bogalusan has been awarded one of Scouting's highest awards, the coveted Silver Beaver.

She is Mrs. Quida D. Standley, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Lester Duncan of Bogalusa. Upon nomination by the local council, the National Court of Honor of the Boy Scouts of America presented the award for outstanding service of an ex-

ceptional nature to boyhood.

Honorees are not informed of their nomination and only the Awards Committee of the Council knows who will receive the award. Mrs. Standley has been most honored in that she is the second woman in the Chehaw Council in which she serves to receive the Silver Beaver.

Though a native of Cuthbert, Ga., she grew up in Bogalusa.

She graduated from Bogalusa High School in 1962, attended Southeastern Louisiana University and received her B.S. degree in Education from Louisiana State University. In 1969 she moved to Albany, Ga. and began to take an active role in community affairs.

In 1973 she began her volunteer work in scouting as a den leader. Subsequently, she has served as a den leader coach,

pack committee member, a member of the Roundtable and the Pow Wow staffs, and as crafts director for the Cub Scout Day Camp. She is presently serving as District Cub Scout Commissioner with 21 Cub Packs under her leadership.

While teaching first grade in Albany, she has continued her education and received her Master's degree from Georgia State University in Atlanta. She

is active in P.T.A., the Dougherty County Heart Fund, and the Council on Drug Abuse Control.

She is the mother of two children, Shel and Leannette. Shel has received his 15 activity pins and the Arrow of Light in Webelos. He will enter Boy Scouts in May.

Her husband Dudley has served as unit commissioner, pack committee member, and is now serving as cubmaster.

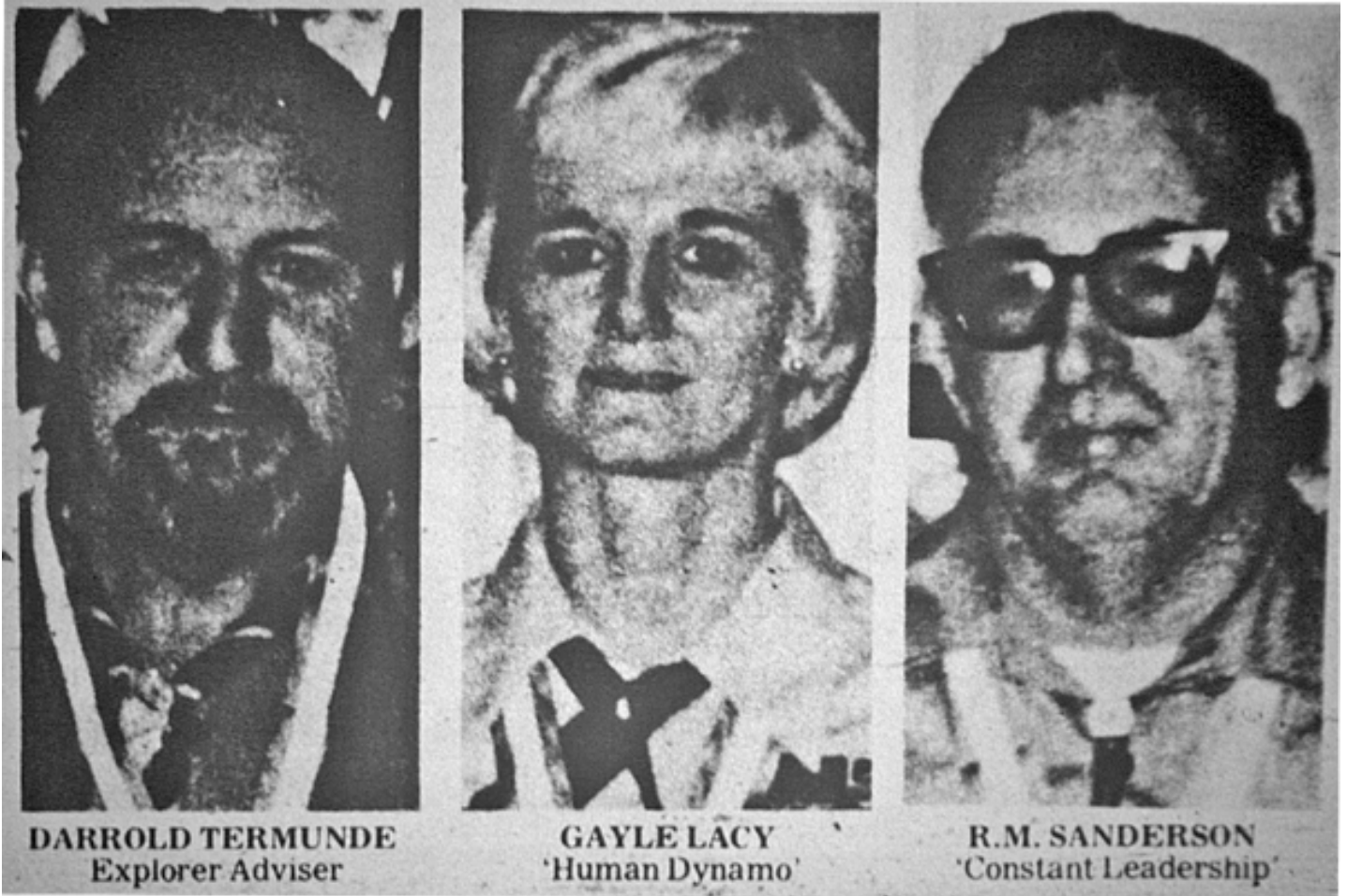

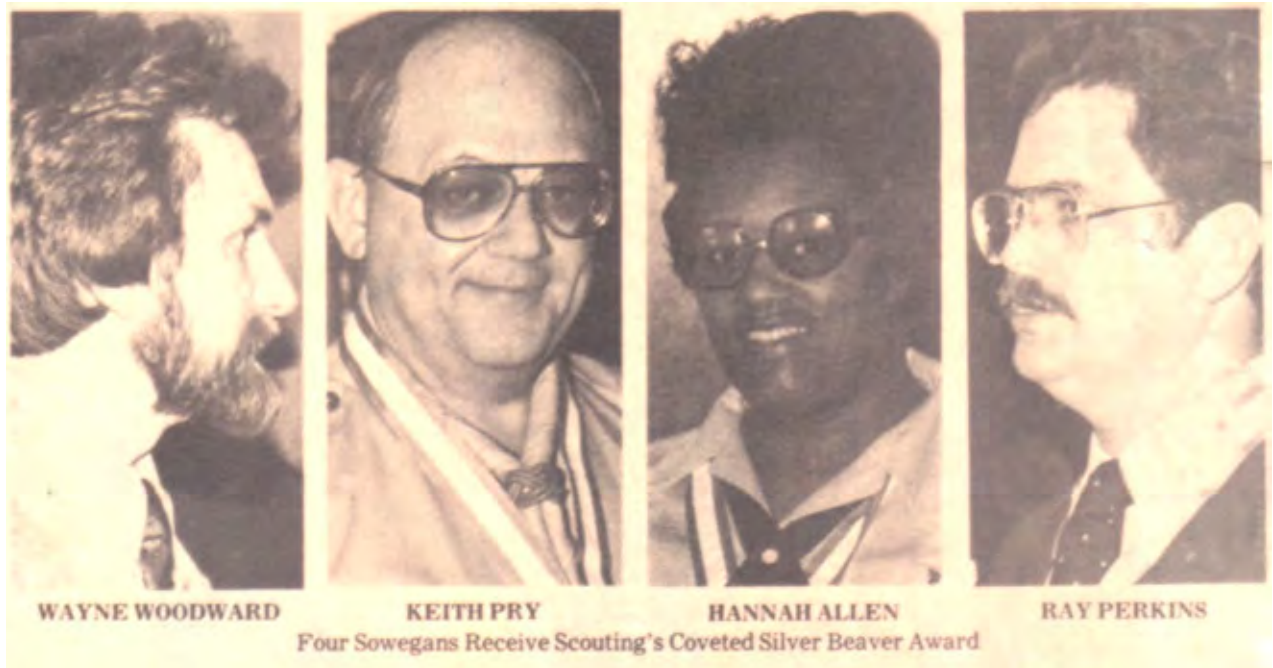

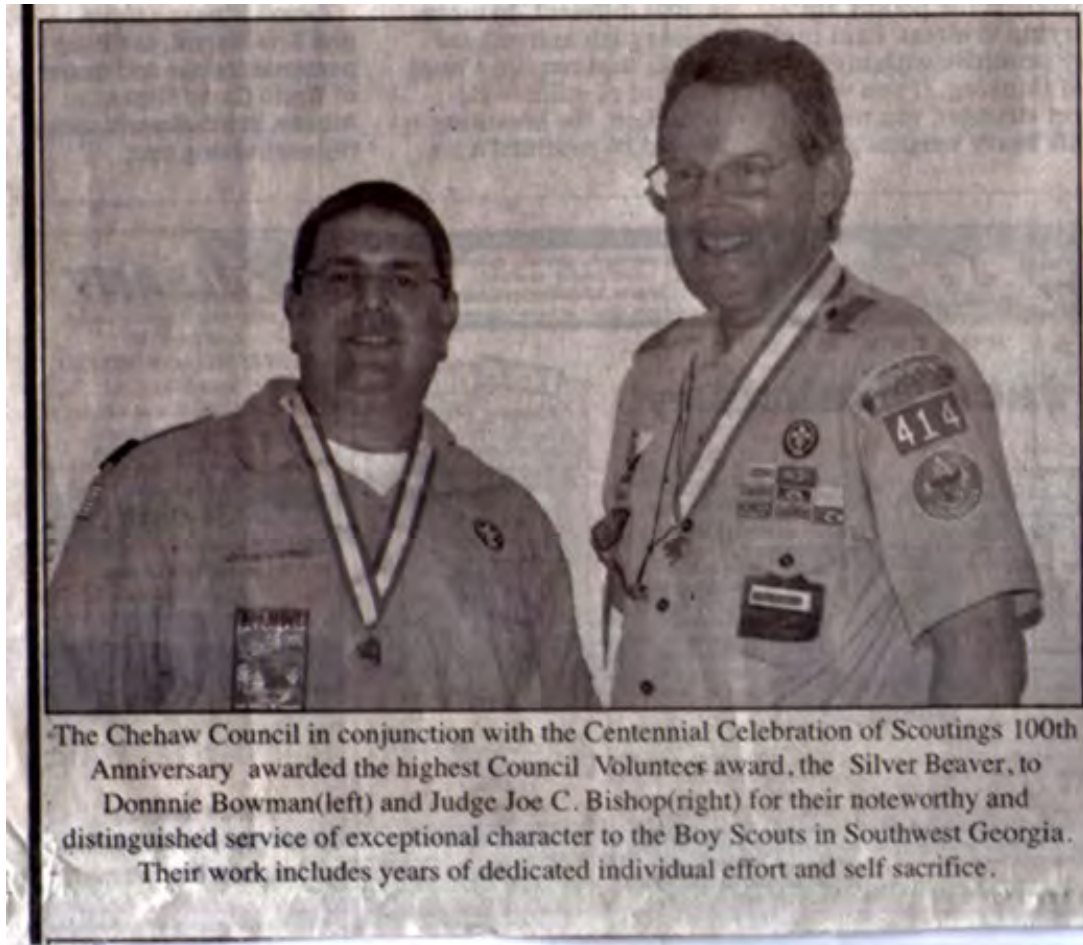
